

Using Clickshare on apple laptop

1. Turn on Display for projector. Once projector fully powers on, make sure Wall VGA+Audio is selected.

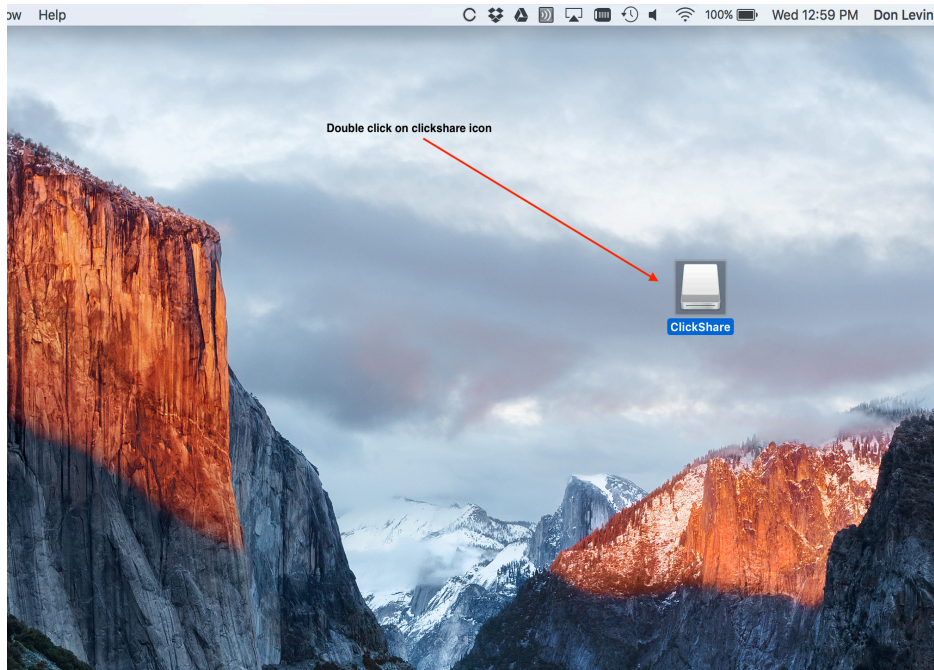


2. Power on Clickshare base. Power button located on back of Clickshare.

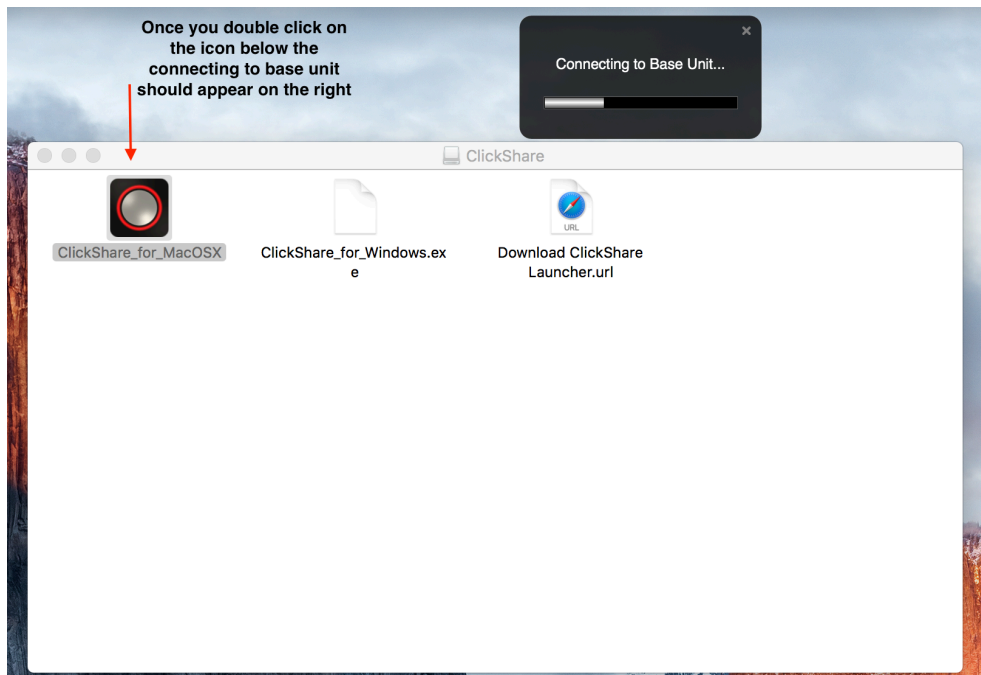


**Wait a minute or two

up.**

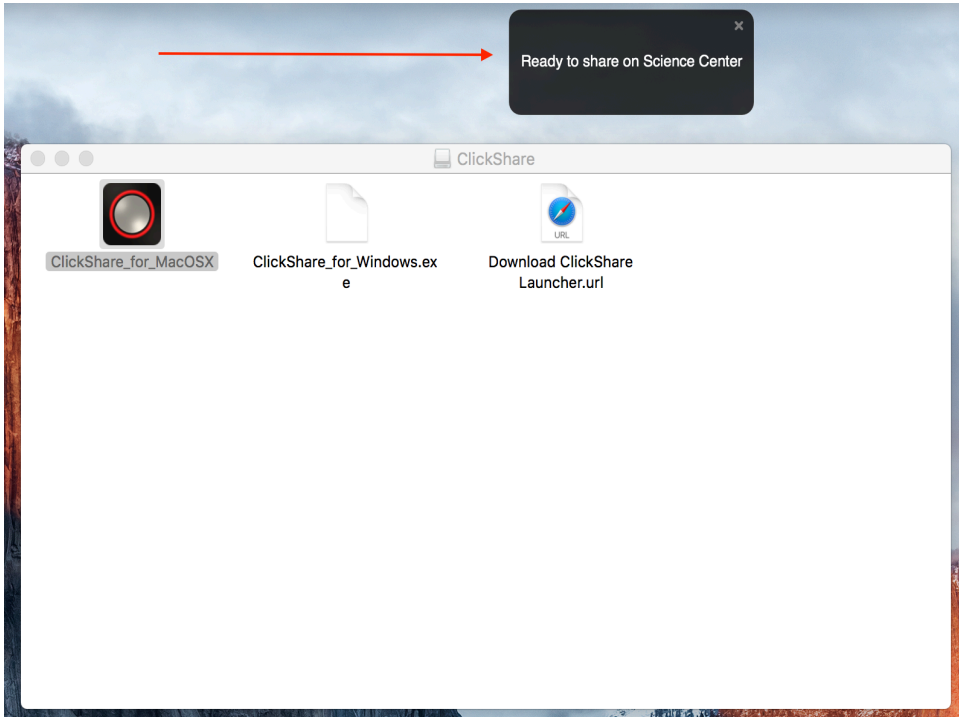
3. Plug Clickshare puck into the USB port on the laptop you would like to present with. A Clickshare icon will appear on your desktop. Double click on icon.



4. Once you double click on icon the screen below will appear. Double click on the Clickshare_for_MacOSX icon. A black screen will appear that says connecting to base unit.

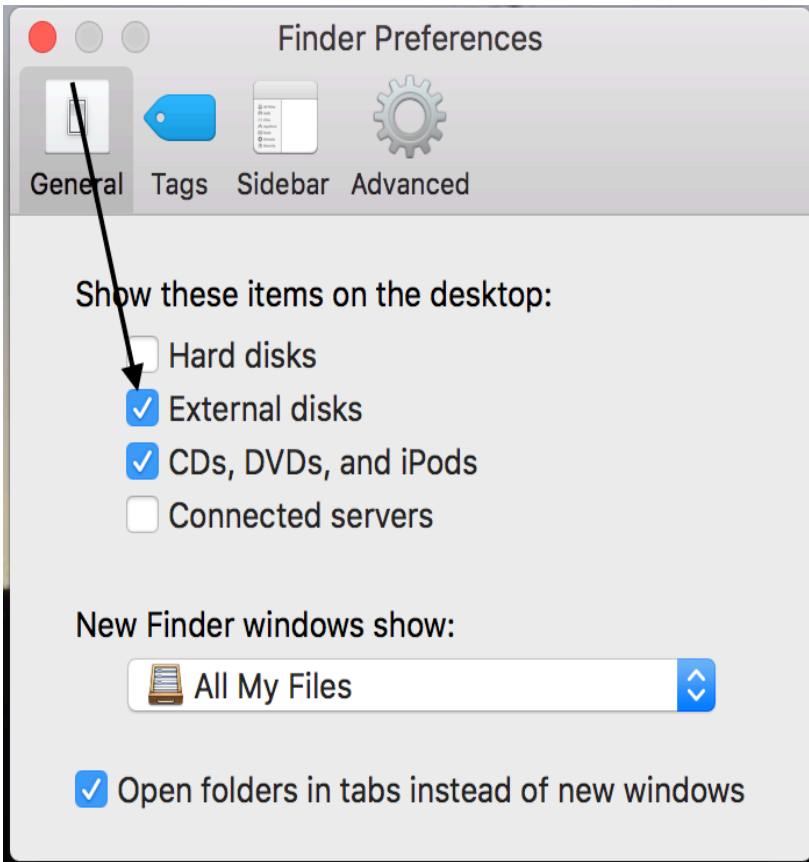


- Once you see “Ready to share on Science Center” you click the button on the Clickshare puck and you will start sharing your screen. When sharing, the puck on the Clickshare will turn red.



*If for some reason the Clickshare icon does not show up on the laptop when you plug the Clickshare puck in: Go to finder>preferences and make sure external disks is checked off.





If Clickshare is not working

- Be sure Clickshare is powered on.
- Be sure blue VGA cable is plugged into Clickshare base and the wall.
